AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF HUNTSVILLE AND MARTY R. CALVERT

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into on the 21st day of December 2023, by and between Marty R. Calvert, an individual, ("Calvert") and the City of Huntsville, Alabama, a municipal corporation in the State of Alabama ("City"),

WITNESSETH

In consideration of the mutual promises and covenants herein contained, the parties do hereby Agree as follows,

- 1. Calvert shall be employed by the City of Huntsville as "Civil Engineer" and shall be classified as a "Special" employee under the City's Personnel Policies and Procedures Manual.
- 2. The term of this contract shall be for a period of one (1) year commencing on the 16th day of January, 2024, and ending on the 16th day of January 2025.
- 3. This contract may be terminated by either party upon thirty (30) days written notice being provided to the other party.
- 4. During the term of this contract, Calvert shall perform the duties and responsibilities of Civil Engineer and shall be under the direct supervision of the Director of City Engineering. Duties for the position of the Civil Engineer include providing professional engineering services including but not limited to the following, (a) Receive and return phone calls, emails, and communicate with the public, contractors, consultants, developers, and regulatory agencies for drainage related issues as a representative of the City Engineering Division, (b) identify flooding, erosion, sedimentation and other related drainage concerns within the City of Huntsville, (c) assist in developing, coordinating designing, prioritizing, and implementing drainage improvement projects, to include providing cost estimates, benefit analysis, and perform engineering design of existing drainage systems and make recommendations for improvements, (d) inspect on-going construction projects and coordinate construction contracts and activities (e) serve as an independent source of engineering expertise to the City at preliminary planning stages of development projects as it relates to drainage infrastructure; (f) review design plans and proposals for economic development projects and evaluate impacts to existing drainage infrastructure and flooding and (g) accompany and/or represent the City Engineering Division at meetings and hearings as directed.
- 5. In consideration of the services rendered hereunder, the City shall pay to Calvert at the rate of \$40.00 per hour for a maximum of 20 hours per week with the total sum Not to Exceed THIRTY THOUSAND AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$30,000.00) per year which shall be paid bi-weekly in accordance with the

President of the City Council of the City of Huntsville, AL Date: <u>December 21, 2023</u> City's regular payroll processing system. During the term of this agreement, Calvert shall not receive any cost of living adjustment approved by the City Council for all other employees of the City. In addition, Calvert shall not receive any benefits available to any employee of the City except those benefits he receives as a result of being retired from regular employment with the City.

- 6. Except as specified herein, Calvert shall be subject to all policies applicable to part-time employment.
- 7. The City shall provide Calvert a parking space during work hours at a location determined by the City's Director of Parking and Public Transit.
- 8. Calvert acknowledges that confidential information may be made available to him in connection with his work pursuant to this agreement. Calvert agrees not to disclose the confidential information to any third party at any time following execution of this agreement. This clause shall survive the termination of this agreement.
- 9. This agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties.
