**BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Huntsville, Alabama, that the Mayor be, and he is hereby, authorized to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement, by and between the City of Huntsville, a municipal corporation in the State of Alabama, and Madison County, Alabama, which said Agreement is substantially in words and figures as that certain document attached hereto and identified as "Intergovernmental Agreement between the Madison County Commission and Huntsville, Alabama, to pave Autumn Branch Drive, Caphsaw Road from Nance Road to Wall Triana Highway and Jordan Road from the roundabout to the Huntsville city limits," consisting of one (1) page, and the date of November 9, 2022, appearing on the margin of the first page, together with the signature of the President or President Pro Tem of the City Council, an executed copy of said document being permanently kept on file in the City Clerk-Treasurer of the City of Huntsville, Alabama.

#### **AGREEMENT**

This Agreement (the "Agreement") is made and entered into by and between the CITY OF HUNTSVILLE, an Alabama municipal corporation (the "City") and MADISON COUNTY, ALABAMA, a political subdivision of the State of Alabama (the "County") This Agreement is effective as of the 9<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2022.

WHEREAS, the County intends to re-pave three sections of roadway (hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Project consist of the paving the following: (1) Autumn Branch Drive (\$43,500.00); (2) Capshaw Road from Nance Road to Wall Triana Highway (\$64,500.00); and (3) Jordan Road from the roundabout to the Huntsville city limits (\$35,562.87); and

WHEREAS, the City and the County have a mutual interest in the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City will contribute financially to the Project.

NOW THEREFORE, the City and County mutually desire to set forth their understanding and agreement as set forth herein:

- 1. The County will begin the Project immediately and will be responsible for the design and construction of the paving and other improvements. Upon completion of construction, the County will notify the City of a final inspection for the City's acceptance of improvements within the city limits. The County will provide the City with a one-year warranty period for all improvements made within the city limits.
- 2. The County will procure all work and materials necessary for said construction in accordance with the Alabama competitive bid laws.
- 3. The City will contribute One Hundred Forty-three Thousand Five hundred Sixty-two and 87/100 Dollars (\$143,562.87) towards the Project in the form of one lump sum payment upon the City's final inspection. After the receipt of said payment by the County, the City shall have no further obligation regarding the portions of the Project that are within unincorporated Madison County.
- 4. The City grants the County full use of and access to all rights-of-way within its city limits necessary for the completion of the Project.
