BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED, that, in the event that a grant is awarded, the Mayor of the City of Huntsville, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with the United States Department of Transportation, Federal Transit Administration for such grant funds and to sign assurances that the City of Huntsville will comply with all applicable federal and state laws, rules and regulations.

Application Executive Summary AMENDMENT No. 02 - July 2022

This grant amendment is for the total amount of \$10,512,079 (\$5,962,071 Federal and \$4,550,008 Local share). It will use carry over FFY 2020 FAST Act 5307 appropriation in the amount of \$1,734,858, FFY 2020 FAST Act 5339(a) appropriation in the amount of \$277,710, FFY 2021 FAST Act 5307 appropriation in the amount of \$2,312,513, FFY 2021 FAST Act 5339(a) appropriation in the amount of \$261,647, FFY 2022 FAST Act 5307 appropriation in the amount of \$1,342,700 and FFY 2022 FAST Act 5339(a) appropriation in the amount of \$32,643.

This grant amendment will increase the total grant award to \$16,877,476 (\$9,324,666 Federal and \$6,644,528 Local Match). The local share will come from the City of Huntsville, Alabama, General Fund. This amendment will fund operating activities, capital equipment acquisitions and rolling stock. This amendment will fund FY22 shortfalls in operating and a negligible amount for capital bus purchase that came in over-budget. This amendment will also fund FY23 operating activities, capital acquisitions and rolling stock.

The City of Huntsville, Alabama, is the designated recipient of Sections 5307 and Section 5339 Formula Program Funds. The FTA funds are not split. The City of Huntsville, Alabama, will ensure that all vehicles purchased are accessible, purchased from an FTA approved Transit Vehicle Manufacturers (TVM), and reported to FTA within 30 days after contract is signed.

The City of Huntsville, Alabama, will check the current listing of Transit Vehicle Manufacturers (TVM) at <https://www.transit.dot.gov/regulations-and-guidance/civil-rights-ada/eligible-transit-vehicle-manufacturers> to ensure each is listed as a certified TVM in compliance with FTA regulations. The city will report vehicle procurement awards online at <https://www.surveymonkey.com/r/vehicleawardreportsurvey> within 30 days of making an award. The City of Huntsville, Alabama, or its sub-grantee (when applicable) will follow all 3rd party procurement policies as defined in C4220.1F (Third Party

Contracting Guidance).

The City of Huntsville, Alabama, and its sub-grantee (when applicable) will ensure contractors procured will not be on the FTA Suspension and Debarment list.
