WHEREAS, the City of Huntsville seeks to expand the opportunity for the enjoyment of visual arts throughout the community, and;

WHEREAS, Arts Huntsville provides management of the City's public art program, and;

WHEREAS, the City seeks to provide facilities for recreation and physical fitness throughout the community, and;

WHEREAS, the City of Huntsville, through license application submitted by Arts Huntsville, applied for participation in the 2022 Arts & Culture and Healthy Cities Series initiative to fund, install and activate a Keith Haring, a Jean-Michel Basquiat, and two Local Artist Outdoor Fitness Courts® and has been selected for participation as one of 10 cities selected across the country, and;

WHEREAS, the City of Huntsville believes the Keith Haring, Jean-Michel Basquiat and Local Artist Fitness Court® programs will encourage healthy lifestyles, highlight Huntsville's commitment to arts and culture and earn local and national recognition for the city as a leader in providing access to Healthy Infrastructure®, and;

WHEREAS, the City of Huntsville is committed to the funding and execution of construction or improvements at Legacy Park, Apollo Park, John Hunt Park, and California Park including both art installations and fitness facilities within those parks.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor is authorized to enter into agreement with Arts Huntsville for the installation of National Fitness Campaign artist fitness courts at Legacy Park, Apollo Park, John Hunt Park, and California Park and to provide funding in accordance with the Council approved respective project budgets.
