SPECIAL EMPLOYEE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF HUNTSVILLE AND JAMES V. CAMPBELL

AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF HUNTSVILLE AND JAMES V. CAMPBELL

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into on the 8^h day of August 2024, by and between James V. Campbell, an individual, ("CAMPBELL") and the City of Huntsville, Alabama, a municipal corporation in the State of Alabama ("City"),

WITNESSETH

In consideration of the mutual promises and covenants herein contained, the parties do hereby Agree as follows.

- 1. Campbell shall be employed by the City of Huntsville as "Electrical Inspector" and shall be classified as a "Special" employee under the City's Personnel Policies and Procedures Manual.
- 2. The term of this contract shall be for a period of twelve (12) months commencing on the 8th of August 2024, and ending on the 8th of August, 2025.
- 3. This contract may be terminated by either party upon thirty (30) days written notice being provided to the other party.
- 4. During the term of this contract, Campbell shall perform the duties and responsibilities of Electrical Inspector and shall be under the direct supervision of the Director of City Inspection. Duties for the position of Electrical Inspector include reviewing electrical plans for compliance with pertinent regulations; advises electricians, contractors, engineers, builders, and the general public in designing or relocating electrical installations in proposed new construction or in existing buildings and in making corrections to ensure conformity with regulations and plans relating to building regulations; secures compliance with codes.

Conducts on-site inspections of electrical installations on residential, commercial, and industrial buildings in the course of construction, alteration, and repair and on completion to assure compliance with codes and ordinances; conducts inspections in cases which involve major structures or unusual problems or disputes.

Inspects and approves new construction for temporary electrical power; performs rough inspections prior to insulation or sheet rock installations; inspects slab prior to concrete being poured and performs final inspections on all appliances, and electrical devices installed.

Reviews plans for proposed small commercial, residential and apartment structures prior to issuance of permits. Investigates defective installation complaints; enforces defect correction; interprets regulations to the public. Issues stop work notice for unauthorized work or work that is substandard, unsafe or in violation of the code.

- 5. In consideration of the services rendered hereunder, the City shall pay to Campbell at the rate of \$45.67 per hour for a maximum of 16 hours per week with the total sum paid to Campbell in calendar year 2024 (including any compensation received by Campbell from any RSA member institution) not to exceed THIRTY EIGHT THOUSAND AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$38,000) and the amount paid to Campbell for calendar year 2024 Not to Exceed THIRTY EIGHT THOUSAND AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$38,000) per year which shall be paid bi-weekly in accordance with the City's regular payroll processing system. During the term of this agreement, Campbell shall not receive any cost-of-living adjustment approved by the City Council for all other employees of the City. In addition, Campbell shall not receive any benefits available to any employee of the City except those benefits he receives as a result of being retired from regular employment with the City.
- 6. Except as specified herein, Campbell shall be subject to all policies applicable to part-time employment.
- 7. The City shall provide Campbell a parking space during work hours at a location determined by the City's Director of Parking and Public Transit.
- 8. Campbell acknowledges that confidential information may be made available to him in connection with his work pursuant to this agreement. Campbell agrees not to disclose the confidential information to any third party at any time following execution of this agreement. This clause shall survive the termination of this agreement.
- 9. This agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties.
