WHEREAS, McCraw not only served her community, but she is also a dedicated wife to her late husband, Homer H. McCraw, Sr., whom she was married to for 75 years, and mother to three children, Homer McCraw, Jr., Denise McCraw, and Dana McCraw Johnson; and

WHEREAS, McCraw strives to live life as a Christian and follows the golden rule of treating everyone with kindness, and, in doing so, she has been a lifetime member of Lakeside United Methodist Church where she has learned that prayer and loving your neighbor as yourself is the secret to leading a long life.
