**WHEREAS** the State of Alabama, City of Huntsville and the greater Redstone Region have a long history of supporting Redstone Arsenal and its mission to continuously provide high quality, effective, and efficient installation assets to ensure unparalleled support for our country's national security, along with defense and aerospace operations; and,

**WHEREAS** as Redstone Arsenal continues to grow and expand its mission, the City of Huntsville recognizes the need for additional and critical infrastructure investments to support this growth and remains committed to providing this support to Team Redstone.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** the City Council of the City of Huntsville, Alabama, does hereby authorize its Mayor to extend a gift offer and negotiate an agreement for an unsolicited gift to Redstone Arsenal in the total amount of \$45,000,000 to support Redstone Arsenal's ongoing growth. This gift offer shall consist of approximately \$15,000,000 to be used for senior leader housing for the U.S. Space Command to be built in accordance with military specifications. Additionally, the gift offer shall consist of the City of Huntsville providing site improvements and proper utility infrastructure and improvements valued at up to \$30,000,000 for the construction for the new and permanent United States Space Command.
