Winchester Road Widening Project Funding - Gas

The City of Huntsville is moving forward with widening Winchester Road from 1,000 feet east of Moores Mill Road to Naugher Road, requiring significant HU gas main relocations. Huntsville Utilities has been requested by COH Engineering to begin relocation activities as ROW acquisition is nearly complete. The relocation is reimbursable through the MPO.

The estimated cost for the gas relocation is approximately \$2.0 million. The project will be consultant designed and contractor installed. This project was not included in the FY25 budget as the timeline was not known.

A Project Work Order approval of \$2.0 million is required for the project. The design cost of approximately \$200,000. Once approved the balance of \$1.8 million will be included in the FY26 budget.

Request Gas Board approval of a Project Work Order in the amount of \$2,000,000 and request subsequent approval from City Council.
