CONSENT TO ASSIGNMENT OF CONTRACT

This Consent of Assignment of Contract is made and entered into on the 25th day of September 2025, by and between the City of Huntsville, a municipal corporation in the State of Alabama, hereinafter referred to as the "City," and MPS (McMillan Pazdan Smith Architecture).

Witnesseth:

WHEREAS, the City and Fuqua & Partners Architects entered into a contract to provide architectural services for the City Hall Demolition (hereinafter the "Contract"); and

WHEREAS, the Contract was adopted and approved by the City Council of the City of Huntsville on October 26, 2023, pursuant to Resolution No. 23-886; and

WHEREAS, Fuqua & Partners Architects is joining and transitioning operations to McMillan Pazdan Smith Architecture (MPS); and

WHEREAS, Fuqua & Partners Architects desires to assign the Contract to McMillan Pazdan Smith Architecture (MPS); and

- 2. McMillan Pazdan Smith Architecture (MPS) hereby agrees to assume Fuqua & Partners Architects' obligations under the Contract, including but not limited to all insurance requirements.

3. McMillan Pazdan Smith Architecture (MPS) will provide the City of Huntsville's Procurement Division with an updated Certificate of Insurance evidencing insurance coverage as required by the Contract.
