The activities funded with this grant application include operation costs to continue to run the fixed route and paratransit programs. Huntsville Transit will replace two (2) 30 ft. buses with two (2) 40 ft. buses. This will accommodate increased ridership on several routes. Huntsville Transit will be acquiring up to 5 passenger shelters and replace obsolete hardware for rolling stock. Huntsville transit will be acquiring two (2) paratransit vehicles.
