**WHEREAS**, the City desires to engage HABITAT FOR HUMANITY OF THE RIVER VALLEY, to provide certain services under provisions of the Act.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Huntsville, Alabama, that the Mayor of the City of Huntsville is hereby authorized, requested and directed to enter into an agreement with HABITAT FOR HUMANITY OF THE RIVER VALLEY, said agreement being substantially similar in words and figures to that document identified as "AGREEMENT BETWEEN HABITAT FOR HUMANITY OF THE RIVER VALLEY AND THE CITY OF HUNTSVILLE, ALABAMA FOR THE USE OF HOME INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIP FUNDS FOR AFFORDABLE HOUSING AT 6221 MAYWICK DRIVE and 6304 MENIFEE DRIVE" consisting of twenty-three (23) pages, including Exhibits A and B, with the signature of the Council President or President Pro tem, and the date March 10, 2022 appearing on the margin of the first page, a copy of said document being permanently kept on file in the Office of the City Clerk of the City of Huntsville.
