Describe the needs of the agency and the problem the project will be addressing,

The Raman Spectrometer is a small portable hazardous material chemical identification meter developed specifically for EOD and HazMat response. It will allowfor quick action and intelligence on suspected explosive and/or hazardous powders or liquids to dispose of the material quickly and properly. This will greatly increase the safety of our EOD and HazMat responders by allowing them to identify these materials with a noninvasive machine instead of having to physically take samples of suspected explosive/hazardous chemicals. We currently do not have a way to test explosive chemicals without having to manipulate and apply flame susceptibility tests to them. This newequipment will eliminate the need to do such invasive tests and allowus to operate in a safer manner.

The 1680 Remote Firing Device is a wireless electric and non-electric firing device that is used to remotely initiate shock tube and electric blasting caps. This is needed to be able to render safe IED's from our robot remotely in a safer and more efficient manner than our current capabilities allow. This equipment will have multiple uses including remotely firing disruption devices on IEDs, firing disruption devices from our robot, remotely detonating explosives at our Bomb range for training and disposal operations.

The frag bags are designed to be able to place an IED or explosive material inside the enclosure and if the device / explosive detonates it will contain the fragments and mitigate blast pressure effects. These are especially useful for most pipe bombs and will allowus to transport devices to a safer place for disposal. This will be used to mitigate the potential effects of an IED detonation in areas that are not able to withstand a blast, such as hospitals, schools, special events, etc. The WASPP Kits are manual electrical wire attack kits designed to take noninvasive electrical measurements on suspected IED's in a non-permissive environment such as a device attached to a person that is not able to be removed. These will be used to safely diffuse IED's that are either attached to a person or in an area that cannot withstand a detonation and are unable to be mitigated with typical means, such as timed devices that are movement sensitive and in a crowded area unable to be evacuated in enough time.
