**BE IT RESOLVED**, by the City Council of the City of Huntsville, Alabama, that the Mayor be, and is hereby authorized to enter into a contract between the City of Huntsville and the low bidder, TRP Construction Group, LLC, in the Not-to-Exceed (NTE) amount of One Million, Ninety Thousand, One Hundred DOLLARS 00/100 (\$1,090,100.00) for the Periodic Traffic Striping and Markings 2025 project in Huntsville, Alabama, on behalf of the City of Huntsville, a municipal corporation in the State of Alabama. The contract time for this periodic contract is one (1) year from the date of award, with services to be provided on an as-needed basis up to the NTE Amount. The City of Huntsville reserves the right to extend the contract for up to two (2) additional one (1) terms with each renewal having a new NTE Amount in the same amount as the initial year. Notification of yearly renewal shall be by written letter from the Public Works Director subject to City Council approval, which said agreement is substantially in words and figures similar to the document attached hereto and identified as “Contract Between the City of Huntsville and TRP Construction Group, LLC for Periodic Traffic Striping and Markings 2025” consisting of one (1) page plus twenty-one (21) additional pages consisting of Appendices B – H, General Terms and Conditions, Supplement to General Requirements Parts 1 and 2, Certificate of Compliance with Title 39 Code of Alabama, and E-Verify Statement, and the date of August 28, 2025 appearing in the margin of the first page, together with the signature of the President or President Pro Tem of the City Council, and an executed copy of said document being permanently kept on file in the City Clerk’s Office of the City of Huntsville, Alabama.



The City will not accept charges for transportation, handling, packaging, installation or out-of-pocket expense other than as specified in the Bid.

Prices quoted to the City shall remain firm for a minimum of ninety (90) days from the date of opening of the bid, unless so stated differently in the bid. If there are discrepancies between unit prices quoted and extensions, the unit price will prevail. The City will be protected against any increase above the price in the bid. Any bid containing an "Escalator Clause" will not be considered unless so stipulated in the Invitation for Bid. Discounts will be considered in determining the lowest responsible bidder, however, any payment term based on less than 30 days will not be considered. Discounts will be figured from the date of acceptance by the City regardless of date of delivery or invoice.


