Memorandum of Understanding

WHEREAS, Family Services Center, Inc. (Homicide Survivors and Crime Victims Program), the Madison County District Attorney's Office, Crisis Services of North Alabama and Huntsville Police Department Major Crimes Unit have been long-term partners in the effort to identify community residents who need assistance with a wide variety of needs, both emotional and physical; and

WHEREAS, the partners listed have agreed to collaborate with **Family Service's Center** in its application to the Alabama Department of Economic and Community Affairs for VOCA (Victims of Crime Act Program) funding; and

WHEREAS, the partners herein desire to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding setting forth the services to be provided by the collaborative; and

WHEREAS, the application prepared and approved by the collaborative through its partners is to be submitted to the Alabama Department of Economic and Community Affairs on or before June 14, 2024;

Roles and Responsibilities:

Family Services Center, Inc. and the Madison County District Attorney's Office will identify homicide victims, as family and friends who have lost a loved one to murder or vehicular homicide, domestic violence victims, robbery victims, burglary victims, bullying victims, and will work together to help clients file for Alabama Victim's Compensation Funds, as needed.

Furthermore, they will work together to assist the victims before, during and after the judicial process with understanding the judicial system, preparing for court, and maintaining emotional support during judicial hearings. The Madison County District Attorney's Office will be the lead agency during all judicial proceedings.

Family Services Center, Inc. and Crisis Services of North Alabama will collaborate to help locate community resources for victims of murder and vehicular homicide, domestic violence, robbery, burglary, and bullying, such as assistance with food, housing, utilities, and other material needs, as needed, and community services that will offer any additional emotional support as needed. Since the Homicide Survivors and Crime Victims Program and Crisis Services of North Alabama serve the entire North Alabama region, they will work together to promote the availability of services provided by both of their agencies to victims of murder and vehicular homicide. Crisis Services will provide non-intimate partner domestic violence reports to the Family Services Center/HSCVP Coordinator.

Family Services Center, Inc. and the **City of Huntsville through the Huntsville Police Department** will identify homicide survivors as family and friends who have lost a loved one to murder or vehicular homicide, domestic violence victims, robbery victims, burglary victims, bullying victims, and will work together to help disseminate information about the free services offered to victims by the Homicide Survivors and Crime Victims Program.

Family Services Center, Inc. will provide the Huntsville Police Department Major Crimes Unit with business cards and flyers listing our services, which may be given to survivors at or near the time of the crime.

Timeline:

The roles and responsibilities described herein are contingent on **Family Services Center, Inc.** receiving funds requested for the project described in the Alabama Department of Community Affairs' Victims of Crime Act (VOCA) grant application. Responsibilities under this Memorandum of Understanding would coincide with the grant period to be October 1, 2024 – September 30, 2025.
