**WHEREAS**, on March 11, 2021, the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) was signed into law which provided for State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds; and

**WHEREAS**, on November 4, 2021 the City Council adopted a plan of spending for the ARPA funds; and

**WHEREAS**, in this resolution a portion of this grant was set aside in support of culture and tourism centers within the City of Huntsville; and

**WHEREAS**, the City met with each of the entities and reviewed the rules and procedures required for funding with ARPA. Projects submitted were reviewed for compliance with the provisions of the interim final rule as provided by the U. S. Treasury; and

**WHEREAS**, The City worked with Counsel to develop sub-recipient agreements which meets the requirements set forth by the U.S. Treasury, and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Huntsville, Alabama does authorize the Mayor and his designees to enter into subrecipient agreements with the Huntsville Museum of Art, U.S. Space & Rocket Center, Huntsville Botanical Garden, Burritt on the Mountain, and EarlyWorks Family of Museums and may engage appropriate persons or businesses in order to execute the agreements.
