AND THE CITY OF HUNTSVILLE, ALABAMA FOR THE USE OF HOME INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIP FUNDS TO CONSTRUCT AFFORDABLE HOUSING AT 6102 TUSCALOOSA DR NW" consisting of -twenty-three (23) pages, including Exhibits A and B, with the signature of the Council President or President Pro tem, and the date January 13, 2022 appearing on the margin of the first page, a copy of said document being permanently kept on file in the Office of the City Clerk of the City of Huntsville.
