5 year lease begins the date that the East Holmes Ave location opens. YMCA will lease 50 spaces in Garage D and provide 51 annual memberships to the city at no cost for City employees and retirees as part of the City's wellness program. YMCA will also provide additional memberships to all employees on a structured fee scale.

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Huntsville, Alabama, that the Mayor be, and is hereby authorized to enter into an Agreement between the City of Huntsville and the YMCA of Metropolitan Huntsville, Inc., d/b/a Heart of the Valley Y, on behalf of the City of Huntsville, a municipal corporation in the State of Alabama, which said contract is substantially in words and figures similar to that certain document attached hereto and identified as "Agreement between the City of Huntsville and the YMCA," consisting of four (4) pages, and the date of November 6, 2025, appearing on the margin of the first page, together with the signature of the President or President Pro Tem of the City Council, an executed copy of said document being permanently kept on file in the Office of the City Clerk of the City of Huntsville, Alabama.

and between the City of Huntsville, Alabama, a municipality (hereinafter referred to as the "City") and YMCA of Metropolitan Huntsville, Inc. d/b/a Heart of the Valley Y., a non-profit corporation in the State of Alabama (hereinafter referred to as "YMCA").

RECITALS

WHEREAS, YMCA desires to locate the Downtown YMCA, an activity and fitness center, in the Huntsville Daily Times Building located at 228 East Holmes Avenue, Huntsville, Alabama 35801; and

WHEREAS, to meet the needs of its patrons, YMCA desires to lease fifty (50) parking spaces in the City's Parking Garage "D" located at 132 Greene Street NE in Huntsville; and

WHEREAS, YMCA will make available fifty-one (51) annual memberships to the Downtown Huntsville YMCA to employees and retirees of the City for no charge and to make corporate memberships available to all employees and retirees of the City; and

WHEREAS, all parties to this Agreement will benefit from the location of the YMCA in downtown Huntsville facility.

WITNESSETH:

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants herein contained, the parties do hereby agree as follows, to-wit:

- 1. The City agrees to make available to YMCA fifty (50) parking spaces in the City's Garage D for its members. Member parking shall be limited to three consecutive hours.
- 2. YMCA agrees to provide fifty-one (51) annual memberships to the City at no cost to the City, which the City may distribute to its employees and retirees as a part of the City's wellness program. The City shall have full authority and control of the distribution of the memberships to its employees.
- 3. YMCA further agrees to provide membership to all City employees and retirees as described and at the price structure below:

Description of Membership Types

Association Wide-access to all YMCA facilities in the Association

Family-Two adults with children aged 22 and under in the same household Single Parent-Single unmarried parent and children aged 22 and under in the same household

Adult-Individuals between the ages of 30 and 59 years old Young Adult – Individuals between the ages 19-29 years old Senior Family-Two adults with one being 60 years of age or older (includes retired City employees) in the same household Senior-Individuals 60 years of age or older (includes retired City employees)

Pricing Structure

- Adult membership \$51.00 per month Association Wide
- Young Adult membership \$35.00 per month Association Wide
- Family membership \$67.00 per month Association Wide
- Senior membership \$48.00 per month Association Wide
- Senior Family membership \$58.00 per month Association Wide
- Single Parent membership \$58.00 per month Association Wide

All "joining" or other initiation fess will be waived for City employees and retirees.

- 4. YMCA agrees to make available to the City monthly reports tracking usage of the YMCA facilities by City employees utilizing the free memberships specified in this Agreement.
- 5. The effective date of this Agreement shall be the date the Downtown YMCA facility opens for business at 228 East Holmes Avenue, Huntsville, Alabama 35801. The term of this Agreement shall be for a period of five (5) years and renewable upon agreement of the parties for one (1) additional five-year term. Upon renewal, the number of parking spaces and/or free annual memberships may be amended by the parties to reflect the actual value of the consideration received by the parties.
- 6. This agreement constitutes the entire agreement of the parties hereto.
- 7. If YMCA discontinues operation of the Downtown YMCA facility at said location during the term of this Agreement, the YMCA's right of use of the parking spaces at the City's Garage "M" specified in this agreement shall cease, and all right in said parking spaces shall revert to the City within thirty (30) days of the YMCA's discontinuance of operations.
- 8. This Agreement, and the rights and obligations of the parties shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the State of Alabama. Venue for any litigation arising out of the interpretation or enforcement of this Agreement shall be in the Circuit Court of Madison County, Alabama.
- 9. Any notice or other communication provided for hereunder will be in writing and may be (i) served by personal delivery, (ii) made by electronic mail or facsimile transmission, or (iii)

any other address which either party may hereafter designate for itself in writing:

If either party hereto changes its address or other contact information for purposes of this Agreement, the party so changing shall give the other party appropriate written notice of change of address in the manner specified above.

- 10. The parties further agree that this Agreement is to be deemed to have been prepared jointly by the parties hereto, after arm's length negotiations, and that any ambiguity or uncertainty existing herein, if any, shall not be interpreted against the other party.
- 11. It is expressly understood that this Agreement sets forth the entire agreement of the parties and supersedes any prior written or oral agreements between them concerning the subject matter contained herein, oral, or otherwise, and that there is no other agreement between the parties other than that contained herein.
- 12. The Parties agree that any form of electronic signature, including but not limited to signatures via facsimile, scanning, or electronic mail, may substitute for the original signature and shall have the same legal effect as the original signature.
