BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the total contract amount be hereby is amended from Fifty Two Thousand Dollars and 00/100s (\$52,000.00) to Ninety-One Thousand Three Hundred Nineteen Dollars and 00/100s (\$91,319.00) on behalf of the City of Huntsville, a municipal corporation in the State of Alabama to, include this Modification No. 1 in the amount of Thirty-Nine Thousand Three Hundred Nineteen Dollars and 00/100s (\$39,319.00), said Modification No. 1 is substantially in word and figures as attached hereto identified as "Modification No.1 to the contract between City of Huntsville and Schoel Engineering Company, Inc, for the Hays Farm Sport Park," consisting of nine (9) pages together with the signature of the City Council President and an executed copy of said document being permanently kept on file in the Office of the City Clerk of the City of Huntsville, Alabama.

MODIFICATION NO. 1

THIS MODIFICTION TO AN AGREEMENT is entered into on this the 26th day of September, 2024 by and between the City of Huntsville, Alabama (Owner) and Schoel Engineering Company, Inc. as adopted by Resolution 22-125 on February 24, 2022. The City of Huntsville does hereby modify the contract to continue providing Architectural services for the Hays Farm Sport Park.

WHEREAS, at the time of hire, the scope of work for the Hays Farm Sport Park was to include the architectural and engineering services for the design of the two soccer fields, a pedestrian viewing area with pavilion and parking lot.

WHEREAS, the scope of work for design services listed in Exhibit "A" of the Agreement Between the City of Huntsville, Alabama, and Schoel Engineering Company, Inc., dated February 24, 2022, as adopted by Resolution No 22-125 is hereby to include the revised scope of work listed in the attached proposal dated September 1, 2024, from Schoel Engineering Company, Inc.

WHEREAS, changes in the scope of work resulted in additional time for construction, field engineering changes due to poor soil conditions, and other unscheduled site visits as required, the additional fee increased and hereby added to the agreement with Schoel Engineering Company, Inc. thereby increasing the overall fee for services.

THEREFORE, the previously established Not to Exceed amount of Fifty Two Thousand Dollars and 00/100s (\$52,000.00) for these professional services is hereby increased by the amount of Thirty-Nine Thousand Three Hundred Nineteen Dollars and 00/100s (\$39,319.00) thereby modifying the Not To Exceed Amount to be Ninety-One Thousand Three Hundred Nineteen Dollars and 00/100s (\$91,319.00).

All other terms and conditions remain unchanged.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

The "project" will include an update of the previously developed master plan to accommodate maintaining and expanding the existing restroom building at Kid's Space, and deletion of the previously proposed new restroom facility. There will be several tasks within this effort which are expected to be as follows:

- Civil engineering design and final construction documents for the construction of two (2) singularly
 cross sloped soccer fields, a pedestrian viewing area with pavilion (designed by others), and a parking
 lot with ROW access from Haysland Road.
- Landscape Architectural services for the landscape and irrigation to be installed as a part of this design.
- Final construction documents for electrical and lighting the ballfields, parking lot, and pavilion, by Hyde Engineering (a subconsultant to Schoel, for this scope of work).

The proposed services to be provided are further described below. Separate fees are indicated for each of the primary tasks to be provided for the items above. Any required structural engineering or geotechnical services will be provided by others and are not included in our scope.

Basis of Design;

The information outlined below indicates our understanding of the project requirements related to our portion of the work

Owner's Project Requirements:

- Work in coordination with the development team to produce final site construction documents to be carried through the approval process with the required regulatory agencies
- 2. The final site plan developed will be based on the approved concept plan to be modified as appropriate.
- 3. Based on the size of the area to be disturbed the requirement for an ADEM permit is anticipated.
- 4. Specifications for the project will be by reference the "City's Standard Specifications for Construction Projects" supplemented only as necessary to cover items not already included in those specifications.

General Requirements:

- The services provided will be in compliance with the local governing ordinances in effect at the time the
 project commences (i.e. applicable zoning, subdivision, and site development, regulations).
- Permit and application fees, if required, are not included within our scope and will be billed as reimbursable expenses.

Limited Additional Topographic Survey

The Consultant will perform a limited scope topographic survey to capture additional items outside of the original topographic survey scope, to aid in design.

Civil Engineering Final Design and Construction Documents

The Consultant will perform final design and prepare construction documents for the site work of the field, parking lot, and pedestrian facilities. This package will be sufficient for final pricing, permitting, and construction. The detailed scope is as follows:

- Coordinate as required with Client and Design Team through milestones
- Coordinate with other applicable governing entities, including municipalities for final approval
- Prepare Final Construction Plans, including the following, as required:

Landscape Architecture Construction Documents

The Consultant will design and prepare landscape plans that will aid in the development of a project budget. This package will be sufficient for final pricing. The detailed scope is as follows:

- Provide a landscape plan for the site in accordance with your general direction and in compliance with local requirements by coordinating with other applicable governing entities, including municipalities.
- The landscape plans will include species, locations, and sizes of proposed plantings
- · Preparation construction plans, including:
 - o Landscape Plans
 - o Landscape Details

Landscape Irrigation Construction Documents

The Consultant will design and prepare irrigation plans that will aid in the development of a project budget. This package will be sufficient for final pricing. The detailed scope is as follows:

- We will produce irrigation design and construction details appropriate to the landscape plans. These plans will include head location and types, and the complete layout of the lines including controller locations. We will provide the required irrigation details and notes needed for installation of the proposed plan. The irrigation plans will include tying into the existing system and coordinate any required renovations.

Subconsultant Tasks

The Consultant shall retain services from licensed & qualified subconsultants to cover design tasks not offered directly by Schoel, upon the clients request.

 Electrical Engineering and Lighting Design to be performed by Hyde Engineering Their Proposal is attached for reference to the identified scope and request for this service.

Administration Services

The Consultant will participate in coordination meetings & conference calls as well as perform limited Construction Review to evaluate the Contractor's general conformance with plans and specifications. The Consultant will review Shop Drawings, and work with the Contractor and Client in solving any minor construction related problems that may arise. The detailed scope is as follows:

- Participate in design coordination meetings & conference calls throughout the design process
- Assistance with project bidding and contracting (pre bid meeting, clarifications and addenda during bidding process etc.)

- · Review of shop drawings
- Construction review for up to 8 separate visits for each construction phase

The Consultant will bill the Client monthly based on work completed during the billing period. Work completed will be based upon a percentage of completion for Lump Sum Fees and will be based on time and materials at the attached schedule of unit rates for Hourly Estimates and Not to Exceed agreements. Payments are due within thirty (30) days of invoice date. The Chent's obligation to pay for services is in no way dependent upon the Client's ability to obtain financing, obtain approval from any governmental or regulatory agencies, real estate closing, receipt of payment from other parties or upon successful completion of the project. If payment is not received within thirty (30) days from date of invoice, the amounts may include a late charge of 1½% per month, calculated from said thirtieth (30th) day. Should Consultant incur attorney's fees for collection of payment, the amount owed to Consultant shall include any and all said fees. Failure to make payment within

sixty (60) days shall constitute a waiver of the right to dispute the accuracy and appropriateness of the invoice. In addition, Consultant reserves the right to suspend services under this Agreement until such time as payment is made in full for all amounts due for services rendered and expenses incurred has been received.
